

South Carolina Trip To USS Yorktown 2010

Tamiami Composite Squadron is planning a summer activity to Charleston AFB in Charleston, South Carolina. We will fly to Charleston, SC via USAF transport plane. <http://www.patriotspoint.org> We are limiting the group to 20 persons. This is due to limited seating aboard the USAF transport aircraft. We are purposefully keeping the group small, because the seating aboard the aircraft is space available.

To lock in our reservations at Patriot's Point, we need to pay them a deposit as soon as possible or we can be bumped from our desired dates. I will begin collecting money not later than 10 April 2010 persons is the maximum per trip and it will be on a first come first served basis.

If we have female cadets attending on a particular trip then we need at least one female Senior escort on the same trip. This is the Patriots Points' policy for the overnight stay on the USS Yorktown. The same policy applies for males as well.

Purpose:

- a. To experience a ride aboard an USAF aircraft
- b. To visit another location away from home for a weekend
- c. Enjoy the sites in Charleston, South Carolina

Cost:

- a. Transportation is free except for gasoline for CAP van, \$20-\$25 estimated
- b. Hotel is \$25- \$35 for Cadets and \$50 for Seniors
- c. USS Yorktown is \$60
- d. \$25.00 for Meals is estimated
- e. Optional spending money

Deposit:

\$25 to lock reservation for the USS Yorktown is immediately due

Date:

- a. Date is subject to change
- b. April 30-May 2

Transportation: will be provided by the USAF and your Senior Members using CAP Vans courtesy of the South Carolina Wing. **We are on standby so there is no guarantee on coming back aboard USAF Airlift. We will have a contingency plan in case this happens. This will be an extra cost if utilized.**

Arrival/Departure:

We will be leaving from Homestead ABF at 5:00 PM, Friday, and arriving back at the same location on Sunday afternoon - the exact time will be announced at a later time.

Sleeping Arrangements:

- a. Friday Night we will be staying at a Motel to be determined
- b. Saturday is aboard the USS Yorktown

Meals

- a. Friday Night and Saturday morning you will be responsible for the cost
- b. Saturday afternoon, evening and Sunday morning will be provided by the folks at the USS Yorktown
- c. Dinner should be eaten prior to coming to the base

Uniform of Event:

BDU's with FLWG Patch, reverse flag and proper CAP name tags. Seniors who don't meet weight requirement must wear Blue CAP Field Uniform. If you do not have a BDU uniform you don't get to go since we will be on a USAF aircraft.

Grooming:

We are representing our Squadron and CAP. We want to look our best. CAP Groom standards will be followed according to CAPM 39-1.

Equipment:

Do not bring any items you do not want to get stolen. You will be responsible for any items you lose. CAP, the event or the Squadron can not be responsible for lost items. **Rule of thumb: If you don't want to lose it don't bring it.**

Suggested items to bring are: **Current CAP membership card and CAPF 60**, linen and pillow or sleeping bag. We get only the mattress to sleep on.

Medications: Must be in original container (this includes over the counter items) with Pharmacy labeled containers with individuals name, medication name, and dispensing instructions must be on label. Medication should be in Zip Lock baggie with your name and CAP ID written on it. Medications are to be dispensed by the activity medical officer.
